# Financial / Maintenance Update – Greg:

- We are behind in Sunday stewardship.
- Finance council will continue to review our banking and loan options at the March meeting.
- Founders Property a subsidiary of Opus is evaluating the building, reviewing the floor in the church and also the outside irrigation system. The roof has been looked at and should be good for the next 15 years.
- ECEC & school budget are complete for the 2019-2020 fiscal year. The parish budget will be completed in March.
- Job descriptions and evaluations will be updated soon.
- The Bailey Nursery contract will be signed. It is \$9,000/year for the extra land that is used by the nursery.
- Greg will be meeting with the City of Woodbury and Washington County on the upgrade to Bailey road this summer. Greg will also connect with the city to see about a slower speed limit during school drop off and pick up times.

#### Volunteer Recognition:
