

# Letter of Request for Confirmation to the Pastor

One of the requirements for Confirmation is that each candidate writes a letter of request. The purpose of the candidate's letter is to share with us why you would like to be confirmed in the Catholic Church. Writing your letter can help personalize why you would like to be confirmed.

## In your letter of request:

- State whether or not you would like to be confirmed.
- Express why you want to be confirmed or not confirmed in the Catholic Church.
- State why you believe you are properly/improperly disposed to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

## Answer the following the questions:

- What is most important to you about being Catholic?
- What do you feel is the most difficult part of being a Catholic teen and why you believe it is still worth being a Catholic teen?
- What has been the most meaningful part of your preparation of Confirmation and why?
- How has your personal relationship with God grown?

## Don't forget...

- Begin the letter with, "Dear Father Williams,"
- Sign the letter with your full name (first and last)
- Use spell check and please have a friend or parent proofread your letter to catch any errors.
- Type your letter and divide your writing into multiple paragraphs so it is easily read.
