Saint Ambrose Catholic Community Safety & Security

Safety and security continue to be one of the top priorities at Saint Ambrose. We continue to work closely with community and regional experts from the Minnesota Department of Public Safety, Homeland Security, Woodbury Public Safety, and 360 Security Services. We look to their guidance and directives to strengthen our safety protocols and emergency preparedness plans.

The safety of Saint Ambrose depends on the vigilance of our entire community. From entering through the correct doors to making sure doors remain secured, each person plays a role in building a safe culture. We have also taken another important step by launching CHIRP-360, a 24/7 online incident reporting system for our community. CHIRP-360 adds another resource to these daily habits – giving every member of our parish, school, and early childhood center a way to report concerns quickly and responsibly.

Introducing CHIRP-360

CHIRP-360 is provided through our partnership with [360 Security Services](#), a company founded on the experience of trusted investigators, analysts, and consultants from federal, state, and local law enforcement as well as the private sector. 360's operational pillars are Protection, Intelligence, and Investigations, which work together in a continuous cycle of improvement to keep our community safe.

CHIRP-360 is being adopted as a proactive strategy to address and mitigate threats or vulnerabilities focused on five critical areas of protection: Cyber, Human, Information, Reputation, and Physical assets. Key features of CHIRP-360:

- Community-Based Tool managed by former law enforcement and security professionals
- 24/7 anonymous reporting with third-party objective follow-up and assessment
- Collaborative investigations with qualified recommendations for next steps
- Intelligence-driven analysis to mitigate threats and vulnerabilities
- Tracking of recurring incidents to identify patterns and ensure long-term improvements
- Continuous enhancement of Saint Ambrose safety practices and protocols
